





Folk Theory

In a democracy, elections serve as a mechanism to keep leaders accountable to the public.

However:

- People don't pay attention to politics
- Voters are overly influence by recent events
- Voting choices are determined by: partisanship, cognitive biases, identity



Spatial Theory


- Think of candidates and voters on a one-dimensional spectrum.
- Candidates will position themselves to attract the most voters possible.
- Voters vote for the candidate nearest them.

BUT:

- What if some people don't vote?
- What if voters can't identify candidates' positions?

Left

- What if candidates aren't static?
- What if the candidate nearest you rubs you the wrong way?






The Social model of voting



- The decision to vote is never made in isolation of others—it's dependent on social context.
- Predictors of Voting:
 - Large personal network
 - More education
 - Older
 - Stake in the outcome
 - Community roots
 - Partisans
 - You've been asked to vote
 - White
 - Wealthy

The answers about why we vote


- Why do people vote?
 - Expression of social identity
 - Solidarity
 - Civic connection
- Why do we have elections?
 - It's not democracy otherwise
 - To provide legitimacy
 - To feel represented, connected




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What a time to be alive...

Cases in the US are on the rise, again.



Dashboard Updated: 10/12/2021 Data entered by 5:00 PM the prior day.





The Delta variant is much more contagious than COVID 1.0.








What a time to be alive...

 COVID-19 is among the top 10 most deadly plagues to have afflicted human in recorded history.

WHO officially declared COVID-19 a pandemic on Mar 11, 2020.


It is hard to calculate and forecast



735-737

Nationwide, Black people have died at 1.4 times the rate of white people.





These calculations are based on data from The Covid Racial Data Tracker and the U.S. Census Bureau. Race categories may overlap with Hispanic/Latinx ethnicity. Rates are not age-adjusted and some rates are underestimated due to lack of reporting of race and ethnicity categories for COVID-19 deaths.


COVID-19 disproportionately affects people of color.

2020 US election was the largest election in US history (66% voter turnout)

Democrats and Republicans do not equally believe the election outcome.

[Percent among respondents who said they got COVID-related news from each source in the past 24 hours]




People who get news from conservative news sources and Facebook are more likely to hold false beliefs about COVID-19.

COVID-19 vaccine status and uncertainty about misinformation

COVID-19 vaccine status among respondents who...

- (1) Identify one or more misinformation statements about COVID-19 vaccines as true
- (2) Do not identify misinformation statements as true, but select "Not sure" at least once
- (3) Correctly identify all misinformation statements about COVID-19 vaccines as false


Partisanship is correlated with false beliefs about COVID-19

The pandemic has been politicized.

COVID-19 misperceptions by political party

Survey respondents were asked to identify the following four vaccine misinformation items as either true or false. When uncertain, they also had the option of saying "Not sure".

- The COVID-19 vaccines will alter people's DNA.
- The COVID-19 vaccines contain microchips that could track people.
- The COVID-19 vaccines contain the lung tissue of aborted fetuses.
- 4. The COVID-19 vaccines can cause infertility, making it more difficult to get pregnant.
- Respondents who marked at least one misinformation item as true
- Respondents who marked none as true, but at least one as "not sure"
- Respondents who correctly marked all misinformation items as false


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Negative Partisanship

Partisan identity is driven by outgroup repulsion

Americans really don't like the other party

How "favorable and warm" respondents rated their feelings toward their own and the other political party, on a scale of 0 to 100

Five things to know about polarization



The trend of contemporary polarization began in the 1970s



Polarization is driven by elites, and exacerbated by psychology



Polarization is rooted in inequality




Parties sorted over racial justice as a result of policy progress and white backlash

Breakdown of systems and norms Inequalities




Polarization degrades democracy

- Democracy is a form of government that protects individual rights, liberties, and promotes prosperity.
- As partisans polarize, people may devalue democratic institutions.
- Democracy requires:
 - Mutual respect among political rivals
 - Mutual restraint
- There are fewer incentives to be restrained and show respect when rivals view one another as dangerous.




Democrats and Republicans live in different political realities

One-third of Americans do not trust the election outcome




Is US democracy in decline? Depends who you ask

Experts see improvement in democracy since Biden inaugurated, but **Trump** supporters perceive a sharp decline

- Multi-member districts

Yesterday was the voter registration deadline.





Who's ahead in the Virginia governor's race?

An updating average for each candidate, accounting for each poll's quality, sample size and recency



Virginia House of Delegates



- All 100 seats up for reelection
- Democrats currently hold a state "trifecta" in controlling branches
- Currently 55 Democrats and 45 Republicans.
- ~22 battleground districts (16 Democrats; 6 Republicans)
- 1993 2017 presidential election winner's party has lost seats in the House of Delegates in 5 of 7 elections.
- Republicans need to flip 6 seats to gain control, which is about the average net seat shift in recent elections.

Virginia redistricting 2021

New congressional districts maps must be approved this year

- Virginia uses a 16-member, bipartisan commission
 - 4 Democratic legislators; 4 Republican legislators
 - 4 Democratic citizens; 4 Republican citizens
- The legislature cannot revise the commission's proposal.
- Virginia has 11 districts, and did not change the size of its congressional delegation as a result of the 2020 census.
- The commission is...not getting along well. Recently lost a quorum. Cannot agree on a map drawing strategy.
- State Supreme Court may wind up drawing the map.

Conclusions

Democracy is not a spectator sport

- If Republicans win Governor or take majority of House of Delegates in Virginia, the state may be seen as "in play" in 2024.
- Nationally, Democrats will struggle to pass major legislation.
- As the number of Americans who do not trust election outcomes increases, democratic stability is gravely threatened.


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
